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


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




- 1. Title of the Practice- Manthan



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

- 2. - **3. Objectives of the practice:** To participate in this activity, a students essentially has to have an all-round participation in Curricular, Co-Curricular and Extra-Curricular activities there by promoting an inclusive yet all-round students Development on the Campus.
- 4. Practice: Our College has a Committee to for the Selection of Best Student under this category. Every Year in the month of January a Notice inviting applications under this category is circulated among students. Out of the applications received, eligible applicants are called foe a written test. Short listed candidates from the written test are called for a round of interview with the committee. - 1. Title of the Practice: K J Somaiya College of Arts and Commerce Employee Cooperative Credit Society
- 2. The context that required the initiation of the practice: Earlier in 1991-92, there was need to have an arrangement to give emergency Financial support to our Non-Teaching employees. Later on Teaching staff also felt need of emergency finance to Celebrate Festivities. Therefore, In 1992, with the Initiation of then principal and Registrar of the college, an Employees Co.op. Credit Society," K.J.Somaiya College of Arts and Commerce Employees Co-Operative Credit society Ltd." Got established.
- 3. **Objectives of the practice :** Prime Goal of this Practice is to give Emergency Loan to our College Employees on the surety of our own fellow members from within the college.
- 4. The Practice: Under K.J.Somaiya College of Arts and Commerce Employees Co-Operative Credit society Ltd, Our Teaching as well as Non-teaching staff members are Given Personal loans up to Rs. 12,00,000/- on surety of 3 members from the collge. This Credit society has an arrangement with Mumbai District Central Cooperative credit Bank from where financial support is availed. MDCC Bank lends money to Our Credit society at a Interest rate of 11.50 % 12% p.a. and then Credit society lends this money to its members on a margin of 1 % p.a.. Our Credit Society also accepts Recurring Deposit from members giving them good rate of return.
- 5. Obstacles faced if any and strategies adopted to overcome them: There are no perceived obstacles as such in managing this activity for the benefit of its members from within the college. However, constant efforts are being made to uphold Trust of its members on the working Committee to ensure smooth functioning on day-to-day basis.
- 6. **Impact of the practice**: As a result of availability of Financial Support under this Credit society, Our N0n-teaching staff, who otherwise would not have received Financial Support from other financial institution owing to Poor financial Planning and Low CIBIL









Score, Could able to take care of their Family needs.

## Best Practices of the library:

**The Library Scholar's Card-** It is an extended library facility to encourage the scholar students of T.Y.B.A./B.Com. of our college is used by 10 students of T.Y.B.A. & B.Com.

Advanced Automation- We have introduced KIOSK system in the Library. RFID tagging and antitheft sticker pasting work has been done. Staff & Students can issue, return and renew books themselves through KIOSK system.
