IQAC Annual Report 2019-20

A brief description of the events held throughout the year is as below:

- A workshop was organized on 15th June, 2019 by Mr. Mandar Bhanushe, Associate Professor cum Assistant Director IDOL, University of Mumbai on Online learning and evaluation for teaching faculty members. It gave an insight into various aspects of digital learning and how it can be used to build effective student engagement.
- A seven days Student Induction programme was organized from 15th July 2019 till 20th July 2019 to orient first year students. This gave them an exposure to the facilities available to them in the campus, Rules and Regulations to be followed and a holistic framework and overview of the forthcoming three years of academic processes. Personality development, sports and culture were some areas emphasized during the sessions.
- On 26th July 2019 a One Day National Symposium was organized in association with Think India on National Education Policy 2019.
