

Certificate Course 2022-23:


Two Credit Certificate Course in Omkar Meditation






# Activity 2 - Celebrated World Philosophy Day - Student Seminar

# DEPARTMENT OF PSYCHOLOGY

The department organised programmes that were coordinated and executed by the students of the Psychology Club, which saw active participation from all the students.

There were sessions organised to address the 'key issues associated with the teenagers'. 'National Mental Health Awareness Day' was observed by arranging a guest lecture on "Mental Health awareness and Stress Management" on 6th August, 2022. Dr Swaroop Bhatankar Nival, practising psychiatrist, guided the students by explaining the need to take care of one's mental health and how to deal with the stress.

The second session was arranged to create awareness about the suicidal tendency found prominently in today's time. On 7th September, 2022, to mark the World Suicide Prevention Day, a guest lecture by an expert in the field was organized on the theme – "Suicide Prevention: How to be an Ally!". Dr Wilona Annunciation, practising psychiatrist, was the guest of honour. In a very interactive way, she narrated her experiences and guided the students in identifying the suicidal behaviors. Dr Wilona gave fine tips in helping the person who may show suicidal tendencies. Students were immersed and actively participated in the session.

On 25th November 2022, Dr Shrirang Joshi, Psychiatrist and Counselor, was invited as a guest speaker to guide the students on exam stress and ways to handle it. The session was organised by the Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) in collaboration with the Psychology Department. Dr Joshi emphasised on the importance of putting in efforts for desired achievement. Speaking further on the topic he counselled the students to avoid last minute rush. He reiterated the importance of working hard to achieve goals. The session turned out to be highly interactive.

This year also the Psychology Department witnessed the achievements of its faculty and third year students in the area of research. Under the able guidance of Dr Atish Taukari, associate professor and Dean – Extension and Research, third year psychology students wrote a research paper based on the experiment designed in the class as a part of curriculum.

# DEPARTMENT OF ECONOMICS

The Department of Economics was instituted in 1960. Its department offers B.A. and B.COM, a three-year duration semester-based course. It has made a qualitative contribution in research activities and education in the field of economics since its initiation. Presently, Dr. Shubhangi Patil is the Head of the Department, specialising in International Economics, Money Banking, and Industry.

The departmental strength consists of six assistant professors, among which four are the Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D.) specialised in various areas of economics. Our department strives to reach a standard of excellence in teaching and research activities. Teaching faculties of the department allocate projects and guide students on different economics related issues. Department offers six papers in TYBA including Econometrics and Mathematics which make the course more practical and skill oriented. Our department has a special cabin which helps students in group learning.

- B.Com. Degree (Three year- Semester System)

Like every year, the department has a certain theme that it strives to inculcate and imbibe into the students. The theme for this year is 'Presentation Skills.' Here, the department has worked to help students improve their Presentation Skills by conducting activities like elocution, symposium, etc..

# **About the Economics Association**

Since 1960, the Economics association has been a part of the Economics Department. # PLASTIC COLLECTION DRIVE IN COLLABORATION WITH 'SAMPURNA EARTH'

As the department caters to all round development of the students, the agenda of the economics department for this year was to make the students more environmentally concerned and accountable. In this regard the Plastic collection activity was conducted in association with Sampurn(e)arth Environment Solutions Pvt. Ltd., Mumbai. It is an organisation working for sustainable development. Plastic collection is an initiative by the economics department to conserve the environment and restrict the use of plastic, promoting the values of reduce, reuse, and recycle. In this activity every Saturday students of FY SY and TY economics bring plastic bags filled with plastic, cardboard, paper, and other recyclable waste.






# DEPARTMENT OF SOCIOLOGY ANNUAL REPORT 2022-23

### **EXPERIENTIAL LEARNING - URBAN EXPLORATIONS**

The department of Sociology organized a field visit for the students of TYBA (Sociology) related to 'Mumbai Darshan', a programme of MTDC on Thursday, 17th November, 2022 from 8 am to 8.30 pm. The objective of the visit was to explore Mumbai city through its past and present as a part of the paper on Urbanization in India: Issues and Concerns.



Students travelled through various landmarks of the "Maximum City", some recent, others with colonial influences and few as ancient heritage structures. As a part of internal assessment, students were required to make assignments related to the visit. Broad themes selected by students were related to the Mumbai Coastal Road Project, History of Gateway of India, The significance of Asiatic Society of Mumbai as a knowledge storehouse, Kanheri Caves, CST Railway Terminus as the lifeline of the city, Sanjay Gandhi National Park as a green space within a concrete jungle, Juhu Beach and the Cleanliness Drive, Rani Baug as a zoological and botanical park and the Tower of Silence.

A total of 13 students participated in the activity.






### DEPARTMENT OF ENGLISH

The second activity guest lecture conducted by Department of English, K.J Somaiya College of Arts and Commerce was on 'Social Media and Cyber Crime. It was held on Wednesday, 25th January 2023 from 11.00 am in the Conference Room of the college. The guest lecture was by Siddharth Chaubey, an alumnus of the college, a law student and a vlogger. Tinal Gupta from TYBA welcomed the audience and the guest speaker. It was followed by Dr. Satyawan Hanegave, Head of the Department, introducing the speaker, He mentioned that such lectures comes under 'Alumni Engagement Programme'. He also spoke about social media and cybercrimes.



Siddharth Chaubey was then felicitated by Dr. Satyawan Hanegave and Dr. Meera Venkatesh with a bouquet and a momento.





Crimes on social media were mentioned and how they can affect a person's mental health. Dopamine crash was discussed, i.e. how a crash of dopamine levels can be confused with depression. Social media or any activity one likes can give a dopamine spike, and when there is a pause or abrupt stop to it, it can lead to a dip in dopamine levels, which gets confused with depression. Related to cybercrimes (on social media), things like various platforms or mobile applications tracking our locations without our consent or knowledge were also touched upon. It led to the point that how privacy on social media, or even when you purchase a device, is stolen, that privacy is a myth.



He ended his lecture by talking about social comparison on social media, Fear of missing out (FOMO), etc. and how we start to compare our lives with that of others on social media. It was followed by discussion а session.

Radhika Taylor from SYBA brought the fun and informative guest lecture to an end with her vote of thanks. 50 students benefitted from this lecture.

The activities of English Athenaeum are routinely conducted every year and are eagerly awaited events in the academic calendar of the college and Department of English. On 9th January 2020, the wait ended and students of Arts and Commerce streams trooped enthusiastically into the Conference Room of the college in anticipation, to listen to the Chief Guest of the day, Ms. Sampurna Chattarji. As the customary inaugural and welcome rituals were duly performed by the in-charge Principal Dr. Veena Sanekar and the Head, Department of English, Shri Satyendra Gaur, it was time for Ms. Chattarji to hold forth on 'What has Life got to do with Literature'.








One of the sociocultural activities was 'Shark Tank', where the volunteers were expected to pitch some great business deals and ideas that would help curb the intensity of any social issue.

**CL Meet:** 


