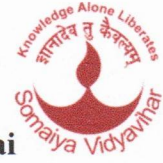

About College

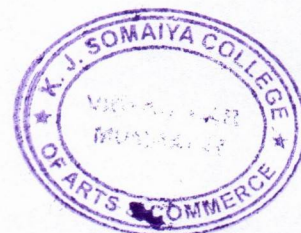
